 Now let's wait for spring!




Airspace Activity- Approach and Departure






NUMBER OF HOUSEHOLDS APPLYING FOR NOISE INSULATION

Noise Complaints - overview




- Each month of 2023 to date saw fewer environmental complaints than in 2022 except June when phone complaints are accounted for


Type of noise complaint - overview




- The majority of environmental complaints were regarding noise and flight paths

- Most recent and technically demanding complaints responded to promptly by the customer relations team




Day and Night Noise Climates 2022 vs 2023




Noise Preferential Routes




Departure and Arrival Tracks – 01/07 to 07/07
