Subject	AIRCRAFT ENGINE RUN TEXT MESSAGE REQUEST TRIAL		

An Airside Information Notice (AIN) will be issued to notify airfield users of pertinent operational or administrative information, such as a general or routine reminder of airfield procedures/instructions, the promotion of safety campaigns and changes to airfield infrastructure, signs or markings. It is the responsibility of all employers to ensure that relevant AINs are brought to the attention of their staff.

1. OBJECTIVE

This AIN is issued to advise of a trial change to the application process for requesting an Aircraft Engine Run authorisation number from Airside Operations via text message. The trial will last from **19 APRIL 2021 until 31 MAY 2021**. If the trial is a success, then a permanent change will be made to Operational Safety Instruction BRS-OSI-ENV-003 Engine Ground Run Requirements.

2. SCOPE

This notice is relevant to all Aircraft Engineers at Bristol Airport.

3. INFORMATION

The ability to text the Airside Operations Team instead of calling will ensure more accurate engine run details are recorded, allow time for a risk assessment to take place prior to authorisation and ensure a more formal approach to engine run requests.

Aircraft Engineers are requested to text the following number **07712 792235** with the following information (minimum 1 hours' notice).

- COMPANY NAME
- STAND / RUN LOCATION
- AIRCRAFT TYPE
- AIRCRAFT REGISTRATION
- ENGINEER NAME
- START TIME AND DURATION
- POWER SETTING / SINGLE OR DUAL ENGINE

Once the required information has been provided, Airside Operations shall review the request and provide an authorisation number. Please note, the authorisation number may not be sent back to you until nearer the planned start time.
