Subject	EQUIPMENT PARKING EAST OF STAND 3		

An Airside Information Notice (AIN) will be issued to notify airfield users of pertinent operational or administrative information, such as a general or routine reminder of airfield procedures/instructions, the promotion of safety campaigns and changes to airfield infrastructure, signs or markings. It is the responsibility of all employers to ensure that relevant AINs are brought to the attention of their staff.

1. OBJECTIVE

This AIN is issued to advise of new restrictions on equipment parking to the east of stand 3 alongside the terminal central pier, to enable OCS coach drivers to park Cobus in this area.

2. SCOPE

This notice is relevant to all ground handling colleagues who operate equipment airside.

3. INFORMATION

OCS will regularly be parking at least two coaches to the east of stand 3, as show below, as part of a revised cobus parking plan. See Operational Safety Instruction BRS-OSI-DVO-007 Version B.

To enable the coach drivers to park safely, no equipment should be parked in the red hatched area on the diagram. All ground equipment must be parked in a marked Equipment Parking Area (EPA).
