An Airside Information Notice (AIN) will be issued to notify airfield users of pertinent operational or administrative information, such as a general or routine reminder of airfield procedures/instructions, the promotion of safety campaigns and changes to airfield infrastructure, signs or markings. It is the responsibility of all employers to ensure that relevant AINs are brought to the attention of their staff.

**This AIN supersedes AIN 2021/12**

### 1. OBJECTIVE

It has become apparent that some airside colleagues have a need to access the western apron stands (specifically stands 31-36) on foot as they do not have access to a vehicle. This AIN is issued to advise of the correct route to follow.

### 2. SCOPE

This notice is relevant to all airside colleagues accessing stands 31-36 on foot.

### 3. INFORMATION

The marked pedestrian walkway has been extended from stand 30 (gate 16) around the perimeter of the western apron as far as stand 35/36.

This route may only be used by ground handling staff, engineers, cleaners and contractors who cannot access the western apron stands or infrastructure by vehicle. The marked walkway does not extend to the head of each stand; staff should proceed onto stand via the head of stand road without entering or crossing a cul-de-sac.

This route is not available to flight crew, who should refer to BRS-OSI-MS-003 *Aircrew Access to Stands*.
