Subject	HIGH VISIBILITY CLOTHING SAFETY FOCUS		

An Airside Safety Alert (ASA) will be issued to communicate immediate safety concerns relating to operations, equipment or environment, and to highlight negative safety trends. It is the responsibility of all employers to ensure that relevant ASAs are brought to the attention of their staff.

1. OBJECTIVE

The Airside Operations team and Airside Safety Leaders will be running a month-long safety initiative throughout August to check and remind colleagues of the correct high-visibility clothing standards.

2. SCOPE

This instruction is relevant to all colleagues working externally airside. This includes the undercroft/baggage hall, outside of any building and those using an airside smoking shelter.

3. INFORMATION

This Safety Alert is in response to a high number of observations involving the airside community either not wearing high visibility clothing with it correctly fastened, or not wearing any at all.

4. INSTRUCTIONS

High visibility clothing must be worn by **ALL** colleagues when walking in airside areas. Drivers or passengers in a vehicle must wear high-visibility clothing when they step outside of the vehicle.

High visibility clothing must be properly fastened to provide maximum visibility to the front and rear of the garment. It reduces the likelihood of other airside users not noticing you, and an accident occurring.
