The Bristol Airport Limited (Land at A38 and Downside Road) Compulsory Purchase Order (CPO)  
2020

To the Secretary of State, Grant Shapps,

I live in Claverham, North Somerset and I object to Bristol Airport's CPO as I will be negatively affected by any expansion of Bristol Airport.

Bristol Airport's application for expansion 18/P/5118/OUT was rejected by North Somerset Council on the 10<sup>th</sup> February 2020. Bristol Airport is appealing this however the date for public inquiry has not been set.

The CPO is an attempt to manage additional traffic from expansion, and implies that Bristol Airport thinks it will win the appeal.

To grant the CPO at this stage is premature. I am also concerned that it would unfairly prejudice the Public inquiry in Bristol Airport's favour and as such, is an attempt to overturn a sound, local democratic decision from North Somerset Council by spurious means.
