I am writing to you in respect of the above matter. I am also writing to you after the official deadline for comment on the above matter, as the deadline was badly publicised and the deadline unreasonably tight given the complications of the pandemic on dailylife.

The CPO application (referred to above) is deally premature for the following reasons:

1. The Airport planning application (ref 18/1/5118/00T) was
refused by North Somerzet Council on 10 February 2020 due
to concern over the negative impact the airport expansion
Nord have on the environment. The Bristol Airport himited
is appearing this rejection, yet the date for the resulting
Public Inquiry has yet to be decided. Therefore it is
grosshypremature and inappropriate for Bristol Airport Whinted
to apply for a CPO before the planing application for the
expansion has even been decided.
