Subject	AIRSIDE VEHICLE WASH BAY		

An Airside Information Notice (AIN) will be issued to notify airfield users of pertinent operational or administrative information, such as a general or routine reminder of airfield procedures/instructions, the promotion of safety campaigns and changes to airfield infrastructure, signs or markings. It is the responsibility of all employers to ensure that relevant AINs are brought to the attention of their staff.

1. OBJECTIVE

To announce the re-opening of the vehicle wash bay with a temporary solution.

2. SCOPE

Airside operators that require use of the vehicle wash bay.

3. INFORMATION

The existing vehicle wash bay was closed some time ago due to complex engineering issues, the permanent fix hasn't yet been resolved, therefore Airside Operations have sourced a temporary solution to ensure airside partners are able to utilise the vehicle wash bay.

A Karcher jet wash has been installed, the equipment provided is owned by Bristol Airport. The Airside Operations team will inspect the jet wash each morning to ensure serviceability. Airside partners are asked to take care when using the equipment to ensure its longevity. Any damage will be investigated through the normal process, with costs being recovered.

Fees and charges associated with the airside vehicle wash bay are being reviewed and more information will be promulgated in due course.

Airside partners that require an induction to the Karcher jet wash should contact us prior to use. Additional signage is being installed to provide guidance.

The vehicle wash bay will be closed when temperatures drop below the manufacturer's operating guidance.

IMPORTANT: WATER ONLY - no cleaning chemicals may be used in the vehicle wash bay.
