12 MPPA Announcement

In May, the Court decided to uphold the planning permission to increase Bristol Airport's capacity from 10 million to 12 million passengers per annum providing enhanced customer facilities for the region's gateway for air travel. The decision is excellent news for our region's economy, allowing us to create thousands of new jobs in the years ahead and open-up new direct links, and support inbound tourism. We will now take forward our multi-million-pound plans for net zero operations by 2030 and look forward to working with stakeholders and the community to deliver responsible growth.



Local Community Fund



So far in 2023, our Local Community Fund, which helps and supports local businesses and communities. has committed to grant over £160,000 to support 46 projects in close proximity to the airport. In total, £1.5 million has been granted to projects in the surrounding community of Bristol Airport since the fund was set up in 2012.

In May, work started on the development of the first ever onsite solar farm at Bristol Airport. The 2.8-acre solar farm will help us achieve 25% of all energy use generated by renewable sources by the end of 2025. The development is also a major component in helping to deliver the Airport's ambitions to be a Net Zero Airport for its Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 2030. The project is forecasted to be completed by Summer 2023.
